- Also known as Frank's Reel
- Shift into 3rd position in mm10, then back to 1st while playing the open E in mm 11, repeat shifts for same phrases
- The mordent symbol (sharp squiggly accent) on the triplets in Irish music stands for a bow treble, a rhythmic accent made by a fast down-up-down bow triplet with pressure creating a crunchy sound
- The turn symbol (sideways S) stands for a roll, is a sequence of notes: principal note, of upper auxiliary note, principal note, lower auxiliary note, and a return to the principal note. The first principal note is played longer.
