Guidelines for Practice Palooza 2020

1. While many students practice between 20 and 60 minutes every day, others who are practicing 5 or 6 days a week might find daily practice a challenge. Therefore, we have established a minimum amount of practice necessary to get credit for one day of practice. Here are the minimum amounts broken down by age:
Ages 3-6: 10 min. Ages 7-10: 15 min. Ages 11-13: 20 min. Ages 14+: 25 min.
2. Only **home practice** counts.
3. Practice must happen **every day**. If you miss a day, you will not get credit for practicing double the next day. However, in case of an emergency, you are allowed **one "oops" day**.
4. Once you have completed your day's practice, your practice partner will initial the Palooza Calendar for that day (or, if necessary, write in "OOPS!") and put your donations near where you practice.
5. Present your Palooza Calendar to your studio teacher at your first lesson after the Practice Palooza end date of March 17. Your teacher will submit your calendar for processing no later than **March 31**.
6. Participants who successfully complete the Practice Palooza challenge will receive a prize, recognition at the Showcase Concert, and their completed calendar displayed in the Suzuki Hallway. Four Practice Partner names will be drawn to win a River Road Coffeehouse gift certificate.

HYGIENE ITEMS:

ARTS & CRAFT SUPPLIES:

Crayons, markers, poster board, scissors, construction paper, beads, foam, pom poms, cotton balls, glitter, scrapbooking paper, colored popsicle sticks, paint brushes, shaving cream, mason jars, hemp/ twine, washable paint, any kind of craft kits, kid smocks, yarn (all colors) clay, playdough, kinetic sand, hot- glue gun and sticks, colorful eyes, colorful buttons, kids magnifying glasses, glue, sharpies, fun themed picture frames, poster board (white and colored), easels and large post -it notes, tie-dye kits, tissue paper, gift bags of all sorts, canvasses, assorted stickers, kid- friendly stationary.

OFFICE SUPPLIES:
